Key Point (2) Show with photo	II. Stroll through the natural wonder of a sacred forest in the crisp early morning air Part of the appeal of Asageshiki is the mystical appearance of Mt. Futaba in the early morning. The trees shining in the morning sun, the soft whisper of the wind, and the warm scent of the earth. At the Kinko Inari Shrine in the mountains, you will be greeted by 120 brightly colored torii gates. Here, you will visit seven gods. Mt. Futaba, where this tour takes place, is home to Japan's largest forest of the endangered Japanese oak Lithocarpus glaber. Step into the forest and find yourself natural surroundings so rich, it's hard to believe it is so close to the center of Hiroshima. Along the way, there are also forest bathing and yoga activities. Feel refreshed and revitalized in the midst of nature. At the mountain's summit, we will reflect on the history and origins of Hiroshima, its connection with Miyajima and Hiroshima Castle, and the city's reconstruction after the atomic bombing.
